### 4. Matters arising and actions from last meeting.

Speed wardens will monitor speed and report to the police who will deal with. Ongoing debate about how insurance will be provided and by who. Police will not cover. lan Monk (IM) has had positive responses from the Conservative, Green and Reform candidates and has invited reporters to cover the story, GACC see the Core Path as a priority.IM has invited local reporters to cover story -he has been campaigning for 19 years.

SPB-Dirleton PS and Heriot Watt want to put up solar display. He explained that it would not be temporary (thus against funding criteria) but taken down each winter. Have permission from Ellie Douglas Hamilton for land use. CC agreed to fund materials. Route will be 1.2 km long.

Has been circulated. ZT reported increase in calls, reduction in crimes. Police monitoring Anti-Social behaviour in North Berwick.

Lot of anti-social behaviour on buses since introduction of under 22 bus passes. ELC trying to introduce other activities to divert away from buses. It was commented that it would be sad if bus pass system removed because of the behaviour of a few. Needs to be consequences for behaviour. How can we support the police?

Comments from floor about how traffic money will be spent, e.g. Hummell Road resurfacing and road lighting in Dirleton. Much reduced budget, down by £15 million. Question: Where do these come from? AF-On the Move Group. Comment that no proper consultation. Report of tow benches in bad state of repair beside Old Smiddy. Councillors recommended contacting John Stevens at FLC.

Grass between Church and school requires cutting. White lines across Golf Court exit need repainting. **ACTION: LA/JF to look into**

## 15.2 Local Place Plans

**Gullane**-has been submitted to ELC. Some feedback, ELC planning officer not totally happy with stipulations for registration of LPP e.g. active travel, core path, upgrade of waste water treatments prior to any new building. Consultation with residents had been held in meeting. **ACTION: ZT will put all LPP on GADDABOUT website.** MD keen not to track back on all the work that has already been done on all the LPPs.

**Dirleton-**draft plan also submitted. Similar response from planning officer. DH not happy with ELC response. At recent NBCAP DH commented that East Lothian had submitted more LPP than rest of country. ZT trying to unpick lengthy feedback, has been very challenging.





**Aberlady-**We are currently undertaking a "second phase" community consultation on some of the priorities and suggestions which emerged from the initial community survey. The intention has always been to have a "sense check" before the draft LPP is composed as there needs to be some consensus about the land use suggestions. Once the plan is written it will of course be shared with GACC and other relevant parties.

MD commented that good that villages had raised similar issues after draft submissions. ? Catch up on submissions at next meeting 29 August.

RH commented that process and requirements have changed dramatically since process started. **ACTION: Councillors will raise with planning department.** 

### 16. NBCAP

AF and FN had attended last meeting.

Issues raised around Abbey Care Home closure and MRT rejected funding application. Application will be re-presented, lot more info requested.

Other discussions around Local Area partnership and issue with quorum. Gullane has 2 votes.
